

MILAN - FONDAZIONE RIVOLIDUE 21 JANUARY - 21 FEBRUARY 2015

THROUGH PAINTING THE EXHIBITION OF MARC BRESLIN, ANA MANSO, TIZIANO MARTINI

The shortlist of 2015 of the Fondazione Rivolidue of Milan (street Rivoli, 2) opens with the collective art exhibition, programmed from the 21st of January to the 21st of February of Ana Manso (Lisbon, 1984), Marc Breslin (New York, 1983) and Tiziano Martini (Soltau, 1983): *Through painting*.

In this way, **Rivoli2** continues its mission of promoting and documenting the path of emerging artists, both Italian and international.

Marc Breslin, Ana Manso e Tiziano Martini are three artists born in the 80s; coming from different parts of the world, they work with the pictorial media in very different way, but they all share the willingness to capture sensations, emotions, feelings through the pictorial act and the space and the time which it "occupies".

The pictorial process is lived as a development of stages which involve not only the formal act but the media itself and its references to "other". We could say that the limit that painting constitutes it is for all three authors a starting point. They could be considered, under some aspect, as descending from analytical painting: painting does not need anymore to represent something to be legitimized, but it is sufficient that it talks about itself, analysing the relationship between the artist and the canvas and the action of the artist and the trace that remains of it.

The investigation that they develop includes the relationship between painting and space, but expanding also to the "non painting", as in the case of **Martini** where the canvas are "painted" from external atmospheric agents and the artist intervenes only to block a natural process in a precise moment, the moment in which himself decides which "image" he wants to stay on the canvas and therefore that he wants to offer.

For Marc Breslin, a Los Angeles based artist who works through the stratification of surfaces and different materials, the basement of the Foundation will become a studio where he will make a series of new paintings and debut a new video, *Avalon Cruise*, filmed on Avalon Boulevard in South Los Angeles which shows an unusual vision of the city.

Ana Manso will present an installation with a wall painting and pictorial works created for the ground floor of the Foundation. She is interested in how images appear to us and in the aesthetic dominium that is generated through the relationship between the images

Biographical notes

Marc Breslin

By using a variety of experimental photographic and pictorial techniques, Marc Breslin evokes collective memories through works that explore the relationship between the visible and the invisible. Born in 1983 (New York), he graduated in History of Art and Literature at the Boston College in 2005. Breslin worked with the American conceptual artist Jenny Holzer for five years. This artists influenced his initial works. At the moment he lives and work in Los Angeles, where he also manages a cultural association focused on music and dance. Ana Manso

Ana Manso was born in 1984 in Lisbon, where she lives and works. Her pictorial work is deeply "tormented" with an intensity in gestures and the ability to evoke meanings without words, almost as vibrations. In 2011 she has been a finalist for the EDP New Artists 2011", Museu da Electricidade and for the "Fidelidade Mundial 2011 Giovane Painters Prize", Chiado 8 - Arte Contemporanea, both in Lisbon. In her career, her main exhibition comprise: Go Between: Works From The Ernesto Esposito Collection, Museo Di Capodimonte, Napoli (2014); Acervo – Artistas portugueses en la Colección Navacerrada- Centro de Arte Alcobendas, Madrid (2014); Sereia, Museu Nogueira Silva, Braga (2014); Group show, Schwarz Contemporary, Berlin (2014); Entre lo Fugitivo y lo Infinito, Maisterravalbuena, Madrid (2013); Under Fire, Galeria Baginski, Lisboa (2012); Z, Galeria Pedro Cera, Lisboa (2013);Transition and Duration, Galleria Umberto Di Marino, Napoli (2012); Gótico, Parkour, Lisboa (2012); O sol morre cedo, Pavilhão Branco – Museu da Cidade, Lisboa(2009); Democracy among Tyrants, Galeria Pedro Cera, Lisboa (2009) e A River Ain't Too Much to Love, Spike Island, Bristol (2008).

Tiziano Martini

Tiziano Martini (*1983, Soltau/D) lives and work between the Val di Zoldo, Milan and Duesseldorf. His works have been exposed in two solo exhibition at the Studio Cannaviello a Milano (2009/2011), at the Galleria

Comunale di Arte Contemporanea di Monfalcone (Studio visit.it 2011) and in the Werkschau Halle in Lipsia (2012); at Mars Milano (Tetris 2013), Palazzo delle Cossere (Oltre lo sguardo 2013), Galleria Cart (Monza 2013), Fondazione Bevilacqua la Masa (97a collettiva 2013). In 2014 he has had a solo exhibition in the spaces of the gallery Otto Zoo in Milan, and many collective exhibition: #painting. about, around & within (Galleria Upp, Venezia), Marquee Moon (Thierry Goldberg, New York), The inner/outside, bivouacs (Museo di Casso, Pordenone), La religione del mio tempo (Kunsthalle Lana, Bz), 2000 Maniacs (arte fiera Verona). He participated to many artist-in-residence including Lia (6 months, Lipsia) Cars (Omegna, winner of 2012), How we Dwell (Vicenza 2014), Landina (Omegna 2014). He is the coordinator and ideator of the project of artist-in-residence *A poem about a chance meeting*,(Dolomiti Contemporanee a Taibon, 2012). He is also the winner of the *Lepsien Art Foundation Grant* for 2014/15 in Duesseldorf.
